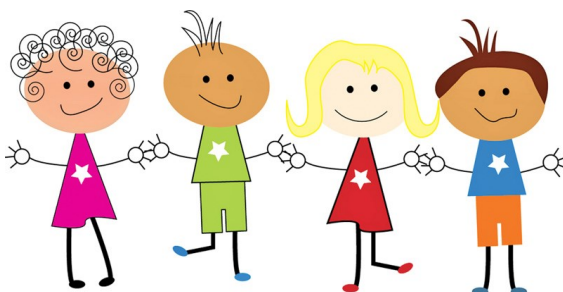

Please remember that children should **only have water in their water bottles (not juice).**

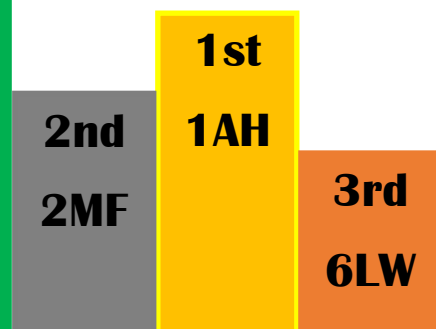
Please also remember we are a nut free school, please do not send snacks/lunch items into school containing nuts as we have several pupils who have serious nut allergies.
