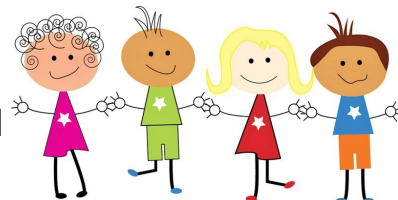
On Friday 10th November we will be completing our Diwali learning and celebration activities.
