Thank you to everyone that joined our market last Wednesday. It was an amazing experience to help our children with their descriptive writing this term. We also managed to raise £142.54!



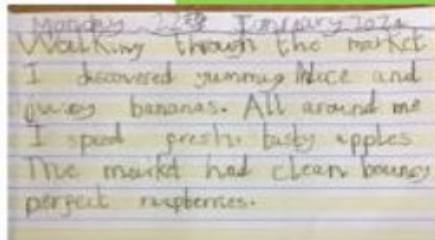
YEAR 1 NEWS
